Here at the University of Central Lancashire Cyprus (UCLan Cyprus), the only British University in Cyprus, we recognise the importance of investing in long-term, mutually valuable relationships which enhance the transfer of knowledge and practical learning. Taking this as a guide, UCLan Cyprus is delighted to bring to your attention scholarship opportunities for **currently registered and practising members** of the Cyprus Bar Association who wish to pursue any of our LLM programmes, namely LLM Master of Law, LLM Financial and Corporate Law and the LLM in International Commercial Dispute Resolution:

Three (3) 50% Professional Scholarships for a September 2024 or January 2025 start, for new applicants, as follows:

From the original tuition fee of the Master's Degree programme of €10,500, the payable fee will be €5,250, for the whole duration of the programme.

These three (3) 50% 'Cyprus Bar Association Scholarships' apply only to **new** applicants, interested in admission for **September 2024 or January 2025**, provided:

- a. they meet the minimum entry criteria of the programme: **an undergraduate degree at 2:2 level or equivalent, plus English proficiency at IELTS 6.5 or equivalent, and**
- b. have scored 'Very Competent' (ΛΙΑΝ ΚΑΛΩΣ) in the Cyprus Legal Council Exams, and
- c. they have been referred to by the Cyprus Bar Association.

The names and Advocate registration number of those approved by the Cyprus Bar Association to receive a 50% scholarship should be notified to the Admissions Office and an application request by each applicant should be sent at admissions@uclancyprus.ac.cy making specific reference to the "Cyprus Bar Association Scholarships". Our Admissions officers will then contact each individual for further information, help and guidance with their application process.

These scholarship opportunities are **in addition to (but not cumulative with) the standard 40% Professional Scholarships** (for September 2024 and January 2025 intake) that **any one of your members can take advantage of** (referred to as '40% Professional Scholarships'). With the 40% scholarship the payable tuition fee becomes €6,300 for the whole duration of the programme.
